“Jesus Lives: Follow Him”

28 March 2021 Palm Sunday Bulletin

Palm Sunday worship would often involve movement, with a procession or at very least receiving our Palm Cross and using it as a reminder as we prepare to remember and recall the climatic events of Holy Week and Easter.

This year, with the exception of Faith ‘n fun, we are once again worshipping at home. You may have a Palm Cross from previous years (I’ve discovered 3 in the past week) and you might like to move it to a different place as a reminder of all that this week holds as the crowd move from jubilation to condemnation.

One way to prepare for Easter is to read the accounts of Holy Week in a Gospel. Mark’s Gospel is the Gospel we’re reading this year, and the last week of Jesus’ life takes up about a third of the text (beginning at chapter 11). On the YouTube channel our worship includes a filmed representation of that account in the place of the reading of the passion.

In some ways, Holy Week and Easter once again feel apart, distant, separate. Our world is taken up with discussion how efficacious vaccines are, who should have access to what and how we support those most in need in our society. But I’m writing this just before going to have my vaccine. Others have spoken about the hope that vaccination brings. Maybe this Easter we have a glimpse of hope through vaccination. But the hope, forgiveness and life that we receive in Jesus is far greater than that offered by the vaccination.

I look forward to seeing many of you on Easter Day, in Lydford and the Sundays that follow.

Morning Prayer Readings etc (these come from #LiveLent, the theme this week is 'Being found by Jesus')

Amazing Grace, a much loved hymn by reformed slave trader John Newton says: 'I once was lost but now I'm found, was blind but now I see.' Earlier in these reflections we thought about lost things. In this Holy Week we think about some of the different ways in which people are found
