"Jesus Lives: Follow Him" Sunday 23 May Pentecost

This week has contained uncertainty for our nation, grim news about the situation in India and a return to violence between Israel and Palestine. Reading the news has been quite difficult and, certainly for me, has raised my levels of uncertainty and concern.

So in the midst of our Pentecost celebrations, remembering the coming of the Holy Spirit on all the disciples 50 days after Jesus' resurrection how do we respond?

In the letter to the Romans Paul tells us that the Spirit helps us in our weakness and enables us to pray, so when we're faced with situations personally, or in our world we can sit before God in silence and ask him to help us to pray. Sometimes we don't have the words, but just being there, maybe with music playing, maybe not we can sense that God is working in that situation.

In John's Gospel Jesus tells us that the Spirit leads us into truth. He helps us to know more about God, his desires, characteristics and love for us and all people. That may mean that the Spirit help us as we work for social justice, care for the environment, look out for our neighbours and one another. Being led into truth isn't only about the words we say, but also how we act and respond to the world around us.

In the book of Acts, we see spectacular happenings as the Spirit comes on the day of Pentecost, John and Romans give us quieter and more restrained views of the Spirit's work. The reality is that we need both, the spectacular reminds us of the Spirit's majesty and power and encourage us in worship. The quieter is also important in enabling us to live our everyday lives under the Spirit's lead and guidance.

May you know God with you wherever you are and whatever you face in this week.
