"Jesus Lives: Follow Him" Sunday 28 November 2021 Advent 1

Happy New Year

No, I haven't lost the plot, well not entirely, this Sunday is the first day of the church year and we begin to read the Gospel of Luke together, for much of the year. There are times when we move to John's Gospel, but Luke is where our focus is.

Luke's Gospel is written by a 'Gentile' a 'Doctor' and an 'Outsider'. He tells Theophilus in Luke 1:1 about his careful research and diligent study prior to writing the text. Some of the themes of Luke that will emerge as the year continues are: the Holy Spirit, Prayer, Women and the poor. A classic example is Luke telling us that Jesus was praying as the Holy Spirit descended at his baptism (Luke 2:21). It is of course Luke who tells us about the angels visit to Mary, and Mary's view of the birth of Christ.

As Advent begins we hear the Old Testament prophets looking forward both to the way that God was going to work in their time and the way that he has worked in sending Jesus, this is the theme of our Advent Course, we're going to look at some of those prophecies which make up the 'Jesse Tree' the forthtelling in the Old Testament of the events of the New Testament. We've met once, but it's not too late to join us!

We've moved to The Rectory since there is room for all there, so please come and join us, on a Monday afternoon at 2pm or a Monday evening at 7:30pm.
