"Jesus Lives: Follow Him" Sunday 17th April 2022 Easter Day

I find that Holy Week and Easter have their own shape and context, for me personally it is difficult to look forward to Easter Day before we have commemorated the arrest, trial and crucifixion of Jesus. In other words, I find it hard to envisage Easter Day on the Thursday of Holy Week!

This year is the first one when we have gathered in our churches for worship during Holy Week for 3 years, and it has been really good to remember together the events of the last week of Jesus' life and remind ourselves of the difference that his death makes for all time.

I've spent part of this week desperately searching my bookshelves for a book, I thought I knew where it would be shelved. I looked and looked there, but then looking for something else found it in another place. I'd put it in a different category. Relief, but I didn't find it because I was looking in the wrong place.

When the women go to the tomb on that first Easter Day Luke tells us that the angels ask them:

'Why do you look for the living among the dead?'

The women thought they knew where Jesus was, they were fairly certain, after all that was where they'd last seen him.

However he had risen, death could not keep its hold on him, therefore there was no possibility of them finding someone alive in a grave. They were introduced to an entirely new lifechanging reality.

Where do you look for Jesus? Do you expect to find him? Th joyous news of Easter is that we don't look for him in a grave but alive and with us, today and every day.
