"Jesus Lives: Follow Him" Sunday 21 August 2022 Trinity 10

Knowing how to respond to those we meet who are in need is often a challenge. Do we give money, or will it just be drunk/spent on drugs? Do we feed their dogs or will that encourage more dogs? What should we do, how should we respond?

Sometimes people have no choice abut the situation they find themselves in, life's circumstances have left them, at other times people have chosen a way of life that isn't our choice.

In our Old Testament reading on Sunday we're challenged to respond to need in a way that brings about structural change, that means that society becomes better equipped to care for the hungry, the homeless and the sick.

In our Gospel reading we see the dangers of following the laws in such as way as to remove care and compassion for those in need. Yes the law is followed but someone who could be given a new life is denied that by the law keepers.

Jesus' response is a fulfilment of the Old Testament reading, in enabling the woman to stand up, to look ahead instead of down he transforms her life, her outlook and her prospects.

Who are we challenged to reach out to?
Who are the hungry we're called to feed and the needy we're to satisfy?
It may not be by direct gifts but by working to change society and situations in such a way as to lead to transformation for many
