### Dear all

Holy week and Easter take us through the full gamut of emotions:

- Excitement on Palm Sunday as we remember Jesus entry into Jerusalem
- Confusion on Maundy Thursday as we learn of Jesus sharing a meal with the disciples
- Sorrow, as we remember the trial and Peter's denial
- Distress at the cross, watching Jesus die
- Confusion, turning into joy on Easter Day as we realise that he is with us forevermore

**Easter Activity Morning** — We will be exploring some of these at our *Easter Activity Morning in Barton St David on 16 April, start time 10:00am – 12:00pm*, with storytelling, craft making, food tasting, sharing tea, coffee, juice and hot cross buns.

Each trip around the trail will take about an hour, and you can start any time between 10:00am to 12:00pm. We start in the hall then continue in the churchyard and church before returning to the hall. Why not make the morning a part of your week before Easter?

### **Easter**

Easter changes everything, and puts a new perspective on all of life. At the moment, life can feel quite tough and at times challenging, because of the world situation or maybe because of something that you're facing. Again please do join us for some of these services, remind yourself of the story and recall the difference it makes.

When the women go to look for Jesus at the tomb, Luke tells us that the angels say to them:

'Why do you look for the living among the dead, he is not here, he has risen'

The women and the disciples were not expecting the outcome of resurrection, they knew where Jesus was, but God surprised them beyond their imagining and expectations. Sometimes we're unsure what is happening, or how to respond to situations. You may find it helpful to use a prayer tree in thinking things through *(see below)* or to take time to stop, to wonder and to pray. But the good news is that we can do that because Jesus is alive and with us.

# **Prayer Tree**

Each of our churches now has a 'Prayer Tree'. Somewhere that you can leave a note of a prayer for a family member, friend, country, situation. You can give as much, or as little information as you like e.g. just initials, no name or a Christian name. There are labels by the trees.

The labels will be left on the tree until the next service in that church. At that point they will be removed, prayed for in the service and the tree starts again... In Barton the tree is near to the altar rail, in Keinton it is at the back behind the font, in Kingweston at the front and in Lydford near the font.

Please do continue to use the churches as a place to sit, ponder, think and pray and if you like leave something on the tree.

**Your church needs you** – All of our churches are looking for people to take part in their life, maybe by helping with cleaning or flower arranging, opening up and locking up. Or maybe by becoming a part of those who are involved in governance and organisation e.g. churchwardens and PCC members. What are you able to offer, and what might you gain from doing so. # Keinton Mandeville Village Hall and Playing Field

Our glass veranda is to be delivered on 15<sup>th</sup> April, *installation on the west wall will take 6 days so there may be some slight disturbance to hall hirers during this time*. The committee intends arranging a formal commissioning event when the weather improves, possibly in April.

# **Hire Charges**

We had to revise hire charges effective in April, although slightly increased, they remain competitive with all comparable halls in the area and there are reduced charges for Keinton residents.

It is possible to book combinations of the main hall, the kitchen and the committee room; the MUGA is available free to be used at any time but can also be booked for sole use.

# **Drive Access to the Village Hall**

The lane leading to the hall is not a public highway and it is frequently used by pedestrians. For safety reasons we ask for drivers' cooperation to limit their speed to below 10 mph and respect the safety of pedestrians.

If you reside in any of these Villages, do not drive or have your own transport, or you find public transport (if it is available) difficult to access, you may be eligible to use the scheme.

Our Community Transport Scheme can be used for, but not necessarily restricted to, journeys up to 25 miles each way to:

- the doctor, dentist, hospital (if free transport is not available), post office, shopping
- friends or relatives (including when in hospital)
- local bus stops, bus stations or railway stations for onward journeys.

Over the years Maggi and her colleagues saved hundreds of dogs and other animals from harrowing conditions. Some were cases of deliberate cruelty or neglect, but many involved owners that were unable to look after themselves – let alone their animals. It was a tough job that involved dealing not just with disturbed and dangerous dogs, but also with hostile and aggressive behaviour from their owners at times.

On a more heartening note, some of the dogs that were considered too disturbed to be re-homed, ended up being successfully fostered by Maggi herself.

# **Lydford and District Gardening Club**



Whilst having a month off is, in many ways, a wonderful thing, such relaxation and leisure can bring a few problems. In a similar way to the difficulties discovered when having to get a phone or computer-

If a system is used very regularly then even aged minds can remember the sequence of 'clicks' which are needed to access certain information or move bits of loose change from one account to another. Harvey the hamster or Bryan the budgie? So life can be a bit complicated and sometimes *'improvements'* may not make things that much easier.

But in amongst this quicksand of existence certain things are set in stone. The weather is guaranteed not to be predictable. March has been so dry that a springtime hosepipe ban is almost a certainty! Plants which were drowning in late February are now parched and gloopy sodden clay soil became rock-hard concrete overnight. In February Abigail Willis came to talk about 'Amazing Garden Innovations'. Perhaps there is a commercial future for that particular invention. All that is needed is a good patent lawyer and the thrust required to enter the 'Dragon's Den'

And then in March, Chris Smith came to talk about vegetables. Lots of other things had a mention as well but veggies were at the forefront of his presentation which was offered in an old-school fashion without notes, visual aids, exhibits or other gimmicks. He spoke about what he knew and that appeared to be plenty. Word had obviously spread about his potential to entertain and the Parish Hall was filled, almost to capacity. More chairs had to be fetched from behind the stage curtain to accommodate all the members of the club who attended and the last time that this had happened was when the Cottage Brewery, of fond memory, began to distribute free beer!

He has won Gold Medals at the Chelsea Flower Show but, seeking a simpler life, was now content to promote his wares in a calmer setting by the banks of the River Brue.

The nursery specialises in heritage vegetable seeds and seed potatoes yet also offers some edible plants and fruit trees. The business works on-line - www.pennardplants.com - but the nursery does have open days and the next one of these is on Good Friday, 18th. April. Many informative gems were offered including the reason for the absence of Pink Fir Apple seed potatoes this year and the rule that cucumber plants should be allowed to fill their pots before they are transplanted.

# Silent 999 calls

In January 2025 Cambridgeshire Constabulary received 31 silent 999 calls where they were needed immediately. Some of these calls were from people suffering domestic abuse who couldn't say much but urgently needed help to escape a desperate situation.

Did you know that if you press 55 on your mobile phone after calling 999 it will alert the call handler that it is a genuine call and you are in a situation where you can't talk but need help?

The call handler will put the call straight through to the police. If circumstances prevent you from speaking, listen carefully to the questions so your situation can be assessed effectively to get the most suitable response to your call.

You may be asked to tap the handset in a way that answers questions or be asked to answer with a simple yes or no. They may also suggest you pop your phone in your pocket whilst still connected so they can listen in to your situation and identify the support needed.

Occasionally, 999 calls are made by accident. If this happens, please stay on the line and tell the call handler you are fine and that it was a mistake – you will be helping them by letting them know that officers aren't needed.


